Midvale Heights Community Association— Working to Make Our Neighborhood a Great Place to Live

The MHCA sponsors several activities and groups for our neighbors over the course of the year. Longtime resident or new to the neighborhood, plan to take advantage of these programs and events.

Good Neighbor Project

Our Good Neighbor Project plans to resume occasional meetings to hear from guest speakers on public safety issues and other topics of interest to neighborhood residents. The group's motto is "neighbors working together for a safe and caring community through cooperation, education and awareness." Youth Baseball

The MHCA summer baseball program sponsors three leagues for children aged 3 to 9 years old, with T-Ball on Tuesday nights, Major Coach Pitch on Wednesday nights, and Minor Coach Pitch on Thursday nights. Games are played at Piper Park,

Annual Neighborhood Picnic

All Midvale Heights neighbors are invited to MHCA's annual picnic in Segoe Park in June. The MHCA provides meat and vegetarian sandwiches,

chips, and treats, along with water and plates, cups, and utensils. Attendees are also welcome to bring additional food and beverages for their picnic, along with chairs,



blankets, and any other picnic needs.

Summer Nights Concerts at Segoe

Summer Nights at Segoe return to Segoe Park annually on Friday evenings in July, with a lineup of bands playing music from Cajun to Irish jigs from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. Bands have included Gin, Chocolate & Bottle Rockets playing and singing pop, rock, and blues tunes, Onadare, a traditional Irish band, the Cajun Strangers, playing Cajun and Zydeco music, and the Madtown Mannish Boys playing Chicago-style blues.

Green Team

The Green Team oversees the Tokay Blvd. median volunteers, the Bison Prairie gateway on Midvale

Blvd., the Southwest Bike Path, and the prairie garden at Odana Hills Golf Course. The group also sponsors Let's Talk events about gardening, sustainability, and other climate related issues at Sequoya Library.



Neighborhood Garage Sale

For 20 years, MHCA has sponsored a neighborhood -wide garage sale over Labor Day weekend. The MHCA prepares maps of all the sale sites, handles all the advertising for the sale, and arranges for the St. Vincent de Paul Society to pick up items that have not sold on Saturday afternoon. This is a great chance to get extra buyers by participating in this group effort. Applications for the sale will be available online in late June.

Santa Visits

Every December, the MHCA helps Santa visit neighborhood children a few weeks before Christmas. Accompanied by one of his elves, Santa brings small gifts to children's homes and chats with them briefly.



Merchant Discount Plan Saves MHCA Members Money

The MHCA board of directors instituted a merchant discount plan for MHCA members. We recruited merchants, focusing as much as possible on locally owned businesses, to offer discounts to our members. Discounts are generally 10%, although they can vary from merchant to merchant, as indicated on the list to the right.

With MHCA dues at only \$20 per household, that means that our members could easily recoup their membership fees by dining at our sponsoring restaurants three or four times a year or patronizing many the service providers listed here.
